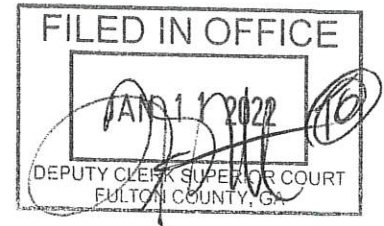

Having read and considered the petitions and criminal records, and it appearing to the Court that sufficient grounds exist that each petitioner meets the requirements for appointment by the Court,


