

STANDING ORDER REGARDING TRANSFER FEE AMOUNT

Pursuant to Atlanta Judicial Circuit Rule 1004 ("Rule 1004"), the Supreme Court of Georgia authorized the establishment of the Metro Atlanta Business Case Division. The Superior Court of Fulton County has, as an Adopting Metro Court as defined in Rule 1004, Paragraph 2, established its own Business Case Division. Adopting Metro Courts have the authority to establish a Transfer Fee, as defined in Rule 1004, Paragraph 6, not to exceed \$2,500. Until further notice, the Transfer Fee assessed upon granting a party's motion to transfer a case to the Business Case Division of the Superior Court of Fulton County shall be \$1,000. This Order does not establish any transfer fee for any other Adopting Metro Court of the Metro Atlanta Business Case Division.
